A National Park will only make matters worse.

Our inadequate roads badly need improvement, especially the A75 and A77, and if money is available, it should be spent improving the lives of residents and growing the economy.

We don't need to squander up to £15 million a year on a political vanity project, with interfering, unaccountable bureaucrats stifling local businesses.

A recent Scottish Environment Link report on National Parks makes clear that tourist facilities take priority. Low paid, seasonal work is not the way forward for Galloway.

We don't need a National Park to deliver better infrastructure to benefit local people, more affordable housing and good jobs for our young people.
